Arizon Companies' MarCraft Division Implements New Protective Shipping Process
New shrink wrap program protects sensitive equipment during shipment

St. Louis, MO— MarCraft® Custom HVAC Systems, a division of Arizon Companies, recently developed a new system of shipping protection for all of its HVAC equipment and components. In the new process, all MarCraft equipment is wrapped using a proprietary process which consists of a heavy-mil shrink wrap system originally developed for ocean-going vessels and yachts. Initial results of the program include very positive feedback from customers, riggers and installing contractors.

The new shipping process was developed as a result of an independent customer survey which MarCraft routinely conducts as part of their *Continuous Improvement Manufacturing and Engineering Program*. Results of these surveys are transformed into weekly and monthly product improvement programs for implementation by MarCraft's engineering and manufacturing personnel.

The sensitivity of equipment controls and components and the overall complexity of MarCraft's custom equipment require protection of the equipment during shipment to the jobsite as well as during equipment storage at the site or at a rigger's yard. The large size (often involving extra wide and super size shipments) limits the amount of protection on open transports. The R&D for the new shipping and equipment protection program required over 12 months in development.

“With the new shipping protection system in place, unit quality and cleanliness can be maintained during shipment, storage, and installation, providing MarCraft customers the best true-custom HVAC solution on the market today,” said MarCraft Division Manager, Doug Howery.
